



Clay County Schools Levy Funded Event Pass FAQ Sheet

What forms of documentation do I need to pick up my event pass?

You will either need a form that proves residence in Clay County (driver's license, utility bill, voter registration, etc) or proof that you paid property taxes in Clay County (tax receipt).

Can someone other than myself pick my event pass?

Yes, but they will need to bring with them your proof of residence or proof of property tax receipt mentioned in the previous question.

What happens if I lose or my event pass becomes damaged?

If your event pass becomes damaged, a replacement will be provided free of charge as long as you return your current event pass. If you lose your event pass, there will be a replacement fee of \$5. You can find the damaged/lost event pass replacement form on the county website.

Who can enter on the event pass?

Only the owner of the event pass can gain entry. Multiple attempted entrances on the same pass for same event will be flagged. However, children in the county, whether they attend Clay County Schools or not, will get in free without a pass.

To date over 500 tax payers and citizens of Clay County have signed up for the event pass paid for by the passage of the excess levy.
