Board Member Conflict of Interest

It is unlawful for a member of the county board of education to be or become directly, indirectly, or pecuniary interested in the proceeds of any contract or service, or in furnishing any supplies in the contract for, or the awarding or letting of, which as such member, he or she may have any voice, influence, or control.

Specific exceptions and penalties are delineated in W.Va. Code § 61-10-15.
